



Students dove into the task with infectious enthusiasm, ready to sculpt their way to a laughter-filled lesson on nutrition.
















Year 8 students conducting food tests!

They observed the transformation as the iodine dilution turned unmistakably blue-black, confirming the presence of starch in the tested food samples.


















Congratulations to Channing Liew Ken Ming for securing an impressive 3rd place in the NRBA Tournament Circuit! Well done, Channing!





The future is now and we must equip ourselves with basic tech knowledge. Well done to our budding tech enthusiasts!
















By visually understanding the roles of each tooth, her students gained insight into the importance of maintaining healthy dental habits for overall oral health.
